

## Fayette All County Honor Orchestra 2022-2023

The Fayette All County Honor Orchestra event serves to recognize and showcase the finest orchestral talent in our schools. **The event will be held Friday, January 20<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and Saturday January 21<sup>st</sup> 2023.**

### Audition Requirements:

A virtual audition must be submitted to your director by Friday, November 4, 2022, 11:59 pm. The audition consists of a scale/arpeggio, and two excerpts. Videos need to be recorded separately, and be viewable by anyone. Videos not viewable by the judges may result in the removal of the student's entire audition.

### Fees:

There is a \$7.00 audition fee, due to your director by Friday, November 4th, and a \$25.00 participation fee for those selected after the audition process due to your director by Friday, December 9th.

### High School Conductor



Young K. Kim is currently the Director of Orchestras at Johns Creek High School in Johns Creek, Georgia. He is a graduate of Georgia State University where he received his Bachelor of Music degree (BM) and Master of Music Education degree (M.M. Ed.). Under his direction, his groups performed six times at the GMEA conference in Savannah, Georgia and Athens, GA (2000, 2005, 2009, 2011, 2015, 2020). He has taken two different high school orchestras to the prestigious Midwest Clinic in Chicago – once with the Centennial High School Orchestra (2005) and three times with the Johns Creek High School Orchestra (2012, 2017, 2022).

Other notable performances include performing at the 58th Biennial (MENC) Music Educators National Conference in Nashville, Tennessee (2002) and the special 2012 Centennial Celebration of the National Cherry Blossom Festival in Washington, D.C. His groups also traveled and performed internationally—participating in five European concert tours (2001, 2005, 2009, 2014, 2019). They performed in Austria (Salzburg, Vienna, Eisenstadt), Germany (Munich), Italy (Rome, Perugia, Florence, Assisi, Cremona, Padua, Venice), Hungary (Budapest), and Czech Republic (Prague).

### Middle School Conductor



David Metrio is currently the Director of Orchestras at North Gwinnett High School in Suwanee, GA, as well as the conductor for the Gwinnett County Youth Symphony. Mr. Metrio has also served as a double bass clinician for the New England Conservatory Preparatory School in Boston, MA. Before his appointment to the Gwinnett County Youth Symphony, Mr. Metrio served as the conductor for the Georgia Youth Symphony Camerata Orchestra for five seasons. Mr. Metrio holds a Master's Degree in Music Education from Florida State University, and has an undergraduate degree in Music Education from Kennesaw State University. Mr. Metrio is in demand as a guest clinician and conductor around the state of

Georgia, and has been invited to present at the Georgia Music Educators Association's In-Service Conference in 2019, 2021, and 2022.
